December General Meeting Summary:

WDFW Biologist Devon Combstock discussed the annual Turkey counts that the WSA does and what they will be used for. She is hoping to have some population summary and statistics for us in the spring. She handed out packets for the various areas that we survey. Surveys will be the first three weekends in January.

WDFW Wildlife Area Manager Ron Fox presented his idea of a designated public shooting area in Swakane Canyon, in the first side canyon that is currently heavily used by recreational shooters. If you have spent much time hunting or hiking in Swakane you know how dangerous it can be with shooters taking up almost every pull out in the road, and unfortunately not always watching closely where they are aiming. His idea is to team local dollars to federal dollars to get an official shooting area built, with concrete benches, roof structures, and varying shooting ranges for the different weapon types and distances. The WSA has committed to both a financial donation as well as volunteer time to help see this through. In order to get this project funded Mr. Fox is asking for letters of support by the end of January. The WSA Board submitted a letter representing the club, but all members who support this project are encouraged to send in their own letters of support. The more the better.
